

Pre-Kindergarten (Child Development) and Kindergarten Registration



Registration for children entering the pre-kindergarten (child development) program for four-year-olds or the kindergarten program for five-year-olds in Georgetown County School District will be held Wednesday, February 29th, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and on Thursday, March 1st, from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at each public elementary school in the county.

Georgetown County Schools offer a program for four-year-old children at each public elementary school. A child must be four years old on or before September 1, 2012, to register for the pre-kindergarten program. Registering a child does not guarantee acceptance into the program as children must be tested to determine if they are eligible.

All children five years old on or before September 1, 2012, are required to register and attend kindergarten unless parents sign a waiver accepting responsibility for their child not being in public school. This waiver is available at the school. **Full-day kindergarten is available at all public elementary schools in Georgetown County.**

Parents should bring their child's legal birth certificate, current South Carolina Certificate of Immunization (shot record) and Social Security card (if available) when registering their child. Proof of residency, current vehicle registration card, and/or legal guardianship will be required by the school administration.
